Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for breach of a **Local Rule** is the General Penalty

Relief from Seams of Cut Turf: Local Rule as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. Model Local Rule F-7.

Aeration Holes: Local Rule as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. Model Local Rule E-4.

Penalty Areas: When a penalty area is defined on only one side, it extends to infinity. When a penalty area is connected to the out-of-bounds edge, the penalty area extends to the out-of-bounds.

White-Lined Areas Tying Into Artificially Surfaced Roads and Paths: White-lined areas of ground under repair and the artificially surfaced roads, paths or other identified obstructions that they are connected to are a single abnormal course condition when taking relief under Rule 16.1.

Integral Objects: Includes all on course stone walls, cables, rods, wires or wrappings when closely attached to trees, and artificial walls and pilings when located in penalty area and bunkers, unless otherwise provided for in Notice to Competitors/Local Rules.

Bunker Liners: An exposed bunker liner is treated as Ground Under Repair, but interference does not exist if the liner interferes only with the player's stance.

Temporary Power Lines and Cables: Model Local Rule F-22 as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect.

Immovable Obstruction Close to the Putting Green: Model Local Rule F-5. Relief is available only when the ball and the immovable obstruction lie in a closely-mown area, the ball lies in the general area, and an immovable obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole. Take relief under Rule 16.1b. No relief if line of play is clearly unreasonable.

Stopping and Resuming Play: Local Rule as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. Model Local Rule J-1. All Practice areas are closed during an immediate suspension for a dangerous situation until the Committee has declared them open. An immediate suspension will be signaled by one prolonged air horn note. All other types of suspensions will be signaled by three consecutive air horn notes. Resumption of play will be signaled by two short air horn notes.

Missing Player or Marker Certification: Model Local Rule L-1 as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect.

When Competition is Final: The competition is final when the trophy has been presented to the winner or, in the absence of a prize ceremony, when all scores have been approved by the Committee. The result of the match is final when the Committee has approved the result as posted on the public scoreboard.
